

Continued Support of Louisiana Recovery FEMA Public Assistance Weekly Update

This week, FEMA obligated more than \$95 Million of Public Assistance funding in the State of Louisiana. ¹

- More than \$21 Million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Recovery School District for building repairs to schools including Lake Area Middle School, Ray Abrams Elementary School, Andrew Bell Junior High School and Dunbar Elementary School.
- Over \$9 Million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to the Roman Catholic Church/Archdiocese of New Orleans for building repairs and content replacement of several schools in the New Orleans area.
- More than \$6.4 Million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to Plaquemines Parish School Board for repairs to Buras Middle School, the science building and Junior High School building at Port Sulphur High School.
- Over \$3.6 Million in Public Assistance funding was obligated to St. Mary's Academy for repairs to its main building, Demetria Hall and for the replacement of contents in the Mother House .

1. Obligated funds are deposited into a Federal Smartlink account. Applicants work with the State to access funds as quickly as possible
