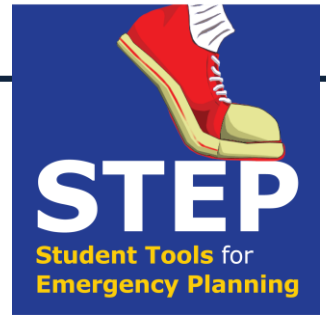

What Goes in an Emergency Kit?
