Compliance Opportunity!!

The Ohio Department of Insurance (ODI) in conjunction with Section 207 of the National Flood Insurance Reform Act of 2004 now requires that agents writing flood insurance receive minimum flood insurance training. The deadline for Ohio agents holding an active license is December 31, 2008. Newly licensed agents must complete training by the end of their first compliance year.

ODI has identified a separate continuing education category named – “NFIP Flood”. These courses have been approved for that designation by the department.

What You Will Learn

This seminar provides a series of building blocks that address not only the most basic flood insurance issues, but some more advanced components as well.

At the conclusion of this seminar, attendees with little or no prior NFIP experience will understand how to write and rate a flood insurance policy.
