
AT YOUR SCHOOL...

1. There is presently in place, a process for making a referral to a professional who can help the child with his/her problems!

A. Contact the School Psychologist

OR

B. If your school has a Study Team, follow this process



• Teacher might also want to talk with the child's parents.

Note * In the Mental Health System, some professionals are specially trained re. specific disasters
 *The M.H. System wants to develop relationships between schools & M.H. Services (Clinics, etc.)

*The outside help might be the County Mental Health Dept. or a mental health professional in the private sector
