

## **FY 2013 TRANSIT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (TSGP) FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT (FOA) – KEY CHANGES**

### **OVERVIEW INFORMATION**

### **FOA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The statutory authority citations for the TSGP and the description of the overarching public purpose for the program were added to the beginning of this section. Also, the detailed 'Application Process' language was pared down to only reference where in the full FOA the complete outline of the application process could be found.

### **FULL FOA**

In FY 2014, TSGP Priorities and Objectives were updated to reflect the Department's focus around National Preparedness System (NPS) implementation and Whole Community approach to supporting core capabilities across the five mission areas of Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery based on allowable costs. Additionally, the Other Critical Information section was updated to include standard language around National Preparedness and National Incident Management System (NIMS) Implementation. Clarification on extension review process and guidelines were added to this section.
