## **Introduction to Functional Assistance Service Team**

**(FAST)**

This training is an introduction to the FAST Program developed in California to provide trained staff to conduct a functional assessment of people with disabilities and others with access and functional needs as they arrive at shelters. This webinar will discuss how FAST members are trained to work with shelter staff and other emergency response workers to meet the immediate needs of the shelter residents. FAST members help to develop and implement reasonable accommodations and generate resource requests for equipment and supplies that will allow shelter residents with disabilities and/or access and functional needs to remain in a general population shelter while maintaining their health, safety and independence.
