

Delayed – Citizen Corps/CERT Registration System Update

The launch of the updated Citizen Corps/CERT Registration system, originally scheduled for today, August 28, will be delayed due to a new FEMA requirement recently placed on the system. We are doing everything we can to meet this new requirement as quickly as possible, and expect that the system will be updated shortly.

We remain very excited about this launch, and we are obviously extremely disappointed about this delay.

Just a few reminders about the new system that we mentioned in last week's e-Brief:

- The link to the new registration page will still be www.citizencorps.fema.gov. That link will remain available on both the Citizen Corps webpage (www.ready.gov/citizen-corps) and the CERT webpage (www.fema.gov/community-emergency-response-teams). Rather than the old Citizen Corps website, that link will go directly to the log-in screen of the new system.
- Citizen Corps and CERT programs will **NOT** have to re-register their program or re-enter their program's information. All of the data will remain in the upgraded version.
