117,664 individuals and households approved for assistance to help with housing and disaster-related expenses

61,441 individuals and households approved for assistance to help with housing and disaster-related expenses

\$1 billion in assistance provided to survivors for housing and disaster-related expenses

\$4 billion in flood insurance payments

CATEGORIES of DISASTER ASSISTANCE

Individual Assistance provides survivors with assistance for housing, damages and other needs related to a disaster

Public Assistance provides federal funds to assist with state, local, tribal and territorial government costs for public works projects

Hazard Mitigation provides funds to help communities reduce or eliminate long term risk to people and property from natural hazards
