

## FEMA P-593, *Seismic Rehabilitation Training for One- and Two-Family Wood-Frame Dwellings*



### TRAINING DESCRIPTION

The training on FEMA P-593, *Seismic Rehabilitation Training for One- and Two-Family Wood-Frame Dwellings*, promotes seismic retrofitting of one- and two-family homes to reduce earthquake damage and increase postearthquake habitability. Participants are introduced to the effects of earthquakes on wood-frame dwellings, common seismic vulnerabilities in these structures, retrofitting approaches, and available retrofitting guidelines.

A primary objective of this training is to develop a common understanding of vulnerable building characteristics, seismic rehabilitation concepts, and rehabilitation priorities that will enable participants to carry on an informed discussion about the extent and cost of voluntary seismic rehabilitation work. This knowledge also prepares trainees to identify for homeowners which rehabilitation measures make most sense and offer the best value for homeowners' investment. Another objective of this training is to identify additional resources that are available for further reading on topics in seismic rehabilitation.
