



FEMA's E-mail Updates: Fast, Free, and Automatic

GovDelivery is the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA's) communication tool for reaching out to the public.

Did You Know...

- You can now subscribe for online information from FEMA and receive **free** e-mail updates on a variety of topics, sent directly to your computer's inbox.
- With individualized topic options that you have selected, you will receive notifications as **fast** as new information becomes available.
- Once you establish a subscription profile, you will **automatically** receive updates without having to check the FEMA Web site (FEMA.gov) for changes.

Subscribing is Easy

If you are interested in receiving information simply visit <http://service.govdelivery.com/accounts/USDHSFEMA/subscriber/new> or go to FEMA.gov, click on the red envelope, and create your personalized list of subscription options. Some of the topics to select from include:

- Updates During Disasters
- Disaster Declarations
- Flood Insurance and Mitigation

As you browse, you will notice that individual pages throughout the FEMA website also feature a button reading, "E-mail me when this page is updated." Clicking on this button will enable you to register for updates to that particular page and topic.

You may select how often you wish to be notified (immediately, daily, weekly, or monthly). Please note that the page you select may not be updated at each of those intervals, depending upon the topic.
