Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

Effective 1/3/18

The following changes have been made to the NOFO that was originally posted on 12/20/17. Please contact the helpdesk (1-866-274-0960) if you have questions about these changes.

- Page 18, the NOFO indicated that the reporting due date for the Federal Financial Report (SF-425) was December 31st. That was updated to January 30th.
- Page 29, the table field for training description was expanded to allow for the full description to be visible. Advanced Emergency Medical was expanded to say Advanced Emergency Medical to Paramedic
- Page 40, the reason for purchase table had a clerical error with the priority listings. The corrected priority for the purchase table is listed below. The correct information is also available in Appendix A, page 22. This does not impact the priority listing for Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA).

Priority		Definitions
H	Replace damaged/broken/inoperable equipment to current standard	Applies to PPE-Turnout Gear that is no longer usable because it is inoperable due to being broken, damaged, and/or for some other reason deemed unusable. Replacement PPE-Turnout gear requested under a grant must meet the most current and appropriate standards for PPE-Turnout Gear.
H	Increase supply for new hires and/or existing firefighters that do not have one set of turnout gear (PPE) or allocated seated positions (SCBA)	Applies to PPE-Turnout Gear for new firefighters (i.e. new hires or volunteer recruits) and/or existing firefighters that do not currently have one set of PPE-Turnout Gear.
M	Replace obsolete/non-compliant to upgrade technology	Applies to PPE-Turnout Gear that is deemed obsolete and/or is out of compliance appropriate standards for PPE-Turnout Gear. PPE-Turnout Gear requested under this reason for purchase has not been deemed inoperable, and while it may not be in compliance with current standards it is not broken, damaged, or otherwise unusable.
