- ZONE A** No base flood elevations determined.

- ZONE AH** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually areas of parking); base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE AO** Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain); average depths determined; base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE A99** To be protected from 100-year flood by Federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE V** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (storm surge); no base flood elevations determined.
- ZONE VE** Coastal flood with velocity hazard (storm surge); base flood elevations determined.

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NOTES

This map is for use in administering the National Flood Insurance Program. It does not necessarily identify all areas subject to flooding, particularly from local drainage sources or small creeks, or all elements of National Flood Insurance Program Flood Hazard Areas. The community map repository should be consulted for more detailed data on NFIP, and for any information on floodway elevations, prior to use of this map for property purchase or construction purposes.

Areas of Special Flood Hazard (100-year flood) include Zones A, AE, AH, AO, AV, VE, V, and V99.

Certain areas not in Special Flood Hazard Areas may be protected by flood control structures.

Boundaries of the floodways were computed at cross sections and extrapolated between cross sections. The floodways were based on hydraulic computations which report to requirements of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

Floodway widths in some areas may be too narrow to show to scale. Refer to Floodway Data table where floodway width is shown as 100 feet.

Coastal flood with velocity hazard (storm surge) is shown on this map as a shaded area. Users should consult the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) for more information on flood protection or other engineering, architectural, flood-control, or other purposes of construction and/or floodplain management.

This map may incorporate appropriate boundaries of Coastal Boundaries Hazardous System Units and/or other protected areas established under the Coastal Barrier Improvement Act of 1990 (P.L. 101-509).
