



Proposed Base Flood Elevation Determination

Peoria County, Illinois

On November 19, 2004, FEMA issued a preliminary Flood Insurance Study (FIS) report and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) for Peoria County, Illinois for public review.

Notice of the proposed modified Base (1% annual chance) Flood Elevations (BFEs) shown on the preliminary FIS and FIRM can be viewed by clicking on the link below. A Summary notice has also been published in the following local newspapers.

Publication of the proposed BFEs initiates the statutory 90-day appeal period provided for appeals and protests to the preliminary FIS and FIRM. All interested parties are advised that the statutory 90-day appeal period will end on November 7, 2005.
