

(LOOKING N. W. – EXISTING STORAGE BLDG.)





**Subject:** Section 7 Endangered Species Act Consultation – Village of Atkinson Fire Station, Henry County, Illinois

The Federal Emergency Management Agency has created an Environmental Assessment for the construction of a 15,500 square feet fire station, storm water detention basin and associated parking lot located at N 41° 25' 1.47" and W 90° 0' 55.31" in Henry County, Illinois. In compliance with Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, a review of the potential impacts to federally listed endangered, threatened and candidate species has been completed. According to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife technical assistance website, the following federally listed species are known to occur in Henry County: Indiana Bat (endangered) and Eastern Prairie Fringed Orchid (threatened).

The proposed site consists of previously disturbed land within the village limits. Proposed project site is surrounded by residential and commercial developments. Project activity will not result in the removal of trees, a potential habitat for the Indiana Bat. No suitable habitat for the federally listed endangered or threatened species is present at the proposed project location.

Based on the site description and project activity, the Proposed Action at the Village of Atkinson site will have "no effect" on the listed species, their habitats or proposed or designated critical habitat.




