

# Framework Current Projected Timeline

- Framework Development (Complete)
- Initial System Integration Testing (Complete)
- Framework UAT System Operational (20 December 2010)
- Final Internal Testing Complete (31 December 2010)
- Initial Acceptance Testing Complete (21 January 2011)
- Framework COG Registration Begins (February 2011)
- Framework Initial Operating Capability (IOC) Go Live Date (?)
- Framework 1<sup>st</sup> Semi-Annual Maintenance Release May 31 2011

This projected schedule assumes successful completion of UAT, FEMA granting IPAWS an Authority to Operate (ATO) for Framework, meeting other internal FEMA dependencies and successfully passing all remaining project life cycle control gates.

# Registration Process

1. Memorandum of Agreement between sponsoring organization and FEMA now required by IT security
2. Two different forms of MOA; one for Framework users, one for users of Third Party systems
3. Framework MOA document in legal review; expected later this week
4. If you had a DMIS Tools COG or signed up to be notified of registration, MOA will be sent to you via email with instructions
  - MOA will also be posted to FEMA Website for download
  - Users of Third Party Software will have a questionnaire to download, complete and return. Customized MOA will be prepared and returned for signature.

## Registration Process cont.

- MOA should be executed by the person authorized by your jurisdiction, e.g. Chief Executive Officer, Elected Official etc.
- Assuming the sponsoring organization is eligible, once the MOA is completed and returned, it will be executed by FEMA and a copy returned to the Jurisdiction
- At the same time, the designated COG Admin will receive a token to complete an online application form
- Once processed by the FEMA System Administrator, COG Admin will receive access instructions
