Enclosed for the above referenced project is the completed AD - 1006 form. The entire project area is located in MU40017, Maplegrove silt loam, 1-3% slopes. Mapping unit 40017 is considered to be prime farmland.

Completion of this project would have a minimal effect on prime farmland for Jasper, Co, impacting <.01 % of the prime farmland for the county.

Maplegrove soils are considered to be partially hydric and could have a hydric soil component of Carl that can occupy up to 2% of the mapping unit. The potential for wetlands exists anytime hydric soils are present.
