Temporary Facility Traffic Analysis

Population:

- 600 Students
- 75 Faculty & Staff
- 7 School Buses

Analysis:

- Out of 600 students:
 - 100 students will drive to school, of these approximately 75 will cross the Mississippian Rail Road (MRR) tracks.
 - 150 students will be dropped of by their parents/others, of these approximately 80 will cross the MRR tracks.
 - Of the 75 Faculty and staff, approximately 35 will cross the MRR tracks.
- The buses will exit off Hwy 25 via Industrial Street and have a dedicated drop off drive and parking on site. Of the 7 buses, 5 will cross the MRR tracks.

MRR:

- The MRR tracks have warning signals for Hwy 25 traffic. There are no crossing arms.
- Pursuant to a phone conversation (28 Jun 11 @ 9:20 AM) with the MRR owner, Buddy Carlisle, the train runs twice a day between 3 -5 days per week.


The most Recent Map for North East Monroe county is attached, hope this helps. The rounded counts are.
