

## TEMPORARY CHILD CARE SUPPORT SERVICES TEAM

<b>DESCRIPTION</b>	A Temporary Child Care Support Services Team provides child care support in a shelter, assistance center, or other locations designated for that purpose. This team will arrive with equipment and supplies for 72 hrs.

<b>OVERALL FUNCTION</b>	This team supports families by providing resources and trained skill sets for child care services for children affected by a disaster.
