

Identification of Project Types

▶ Type A Projects:

No potential for adverse environmental impact

- Review completed by Program Analyst
- Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) under 44 CFR Part 10
- **CFR Categories:** Management and Administration (CATEX i), Planning (CATEX iii), Classroom-based Training (CATEX v), Tabletop Exercises and Functional Exercises (CATEX v), Training and Operational Exercises in Existing Facilities (CATEX v), Purchase of Mobile and Portable Equipment (CATEX vi)

▶ Type B Projects:

Potential for extraordinary circumstances identified

- Review completed by GPD EHP Team
- Upon review, no impacts to resources and no Agency consultation required
- Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) under 44 CFR Part 10
- **CFR Categories:** Physical Security Enhancements (CATEX ix, xv), Renovations/Upgrades/Modifications to structures (CATEX xv, xvi, xvii)



Identification of Project Types (*continued*)

▶ Type C Projects:

Extraordinary circumstance identified

- Potential impacts to resources
- Agency consultations required
- Review completed by Regional Environmental Officer (REO)
- Additional information may be needed to determine scope, impact and level of review

If no adverse effect to resources REO issues a Record of Environmental Consideration (REC)

If adverse effect to resources

- Under the Programmatic Environmental Assessment (PEA) or Tiered Environmental Assessment (TEA) REO issues a REC and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI)

Construction of Towers over 200 ft in height or large construction projects

- Stand Alone EA (SEA) is prepared for the REO to issue a REC and FONSI
