

FY 2013 TRIBAL HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (THSGP) FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT (FOA) – KEY CHANGES

OVERVIEW INFORMATION

There were no changes made under the program's Overview Information section of the FOA.

FOA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Indirect Cost information was added to inform grantees of allowability, approval process, and evaluation.

FULL FOA

In FY 2013, THSGP Program Priorities and Objectives were updated to reflect the Department's focus around National Preparedness System (NPS) implementation and Whole Community approach to supporting core capabilities across the five mission areas of Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery based on allowable costs.

Additionally, the Program Objectives section was expanded from FY 2012 to the following additional priorities:

1. Strengthening Governance
2. Integration of strategic foresight into building out emergency management strategies, and implementing action plan

The Other Critical Information section was updated to include standard language around National Preparedness, National Incident Management System (NIMS) Implementation, and Threat and Hazard Identification and Risk Assessment (THIRA).

APPENDICES

Appendix A: Messaging around THSGP's priorities was updated to include alignment to NPS; Building and Sustaining Core Capabilities; THIRA and Capability Estimation; and Strengthening Governance Integration. The language associated with THIRA and Capability Estimation includes the requirement that FY 2013 THSGP awardees complete and submit a THIRA, and authorizes the use of grant funds to support THIRA development.
