

FY 2013 PORT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (PSGP) FUNDING OPPORTUNITY ANNOUNCEMENT (FOA) – KEY CHANGES

OVERVIEW INFORMATION

There were no changes made under the program's Overview Information section of the FOA.

FOA EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Indirect Cost information was added to inform grantees of allowability, approval process, and evaluation.

FULL FOA

In FY 2013, PSGP Priorities and Objectives were updated to reflect the Department's focus around National Preparedness System (NPS) implementation and Whole Community approach to supporting core capabilities across the five mission areas of Prevention, Protection, Mitigation, Response, and Recovery based on allowable costs. Additionally, the Other Critical Information section was updated to include standard language around National Preparedness and National Incident Management System (NIMS) Implementation.

All reference to Central Contractor Registration (CCR), were revised to reflect the change to the new System for Award Management (SAM).

APPENDICES

Appendix A: In order to provide more full-and-open competition FY 2013 PSGP will have two eligible groups rather than four eligible groups as in FY 2012. Group 1 consists of the top 8 highest risk ports as determined by the DHS risk formula and would compete for 60% of funding available. Group 2 includes all of the other eligible port areas and would compete for the remaining 40% of funding available. There will be full competition within each of the two groups. Historically, Group 1 has included only 7 Port Areas. This year Delaware Bay dropped to #8 due to San Diego's increase from #9 to #7; therefore Group 1 will include 8 Port Areas to keep Delaware Bay in the same group.
