




Figure 1: General Location of NYULMC






Figure 3: Conceptual Emergency Department Site Plan


Figure 4: Project Area for Proposed Kimmel Pavilion and Energy Building



Existing Campus Plan



Figure 5: Project Area for Proposed Science Building





Figure 6: Conceptual Floodwall Boundaries





Figure 9: Floodplain Preliminary Workmap Detail






Figure 10: Environmental Justice Map – Below Poverty




