In groups the students rotated to stations lead by Metropolitan Police Department, Fire & EMS, Homeland Security Emergency Management Agency (DC-HSEMA), Department of Health, American Red Cross, Washington Area Bike Association (WABA), Washington Humane Society, and the National Guard. The stations were very interactive, allowing students to travel through decontamination tents with MPD, learn about horses that some MPD Officers use for crowd control and special events, the proper procedure for washing hands with the Department of Health and safe ways to exit the home in case of a fire with American Red Cross. Washington Area Bike Association taught the children safety procedures for riding a bike such as how to properly wear a helmet and what to do when approaching crosswalks. Each station was also responsible for distributing different emergency preparedness items to students. Each student collected the items in order to assemble a completed emergency GO KIT! By the end of the program, each child took home a Commander Ready emergency preparedness Go Kit and extra information to share with their families.
