



**Continued Support of Louisiana Recovery
 FEMA Public Assistance Weekly Update**

- This week, FEMA obligated over \$31 Million in Public Assistance funds to the State of Louisiana.
- Approximately \$7.5 million in funding was obligated to repair damaged buildings at Andrew Jackson High School in St. Bernard Parish.
- Over \$1.4 million in funding was obligated to repair the science building at Port Sulphur High School in Plaquemines Parish.
- Nearly \$1.6 million in funding was obligated to Plaquemines Parish for major repairs and replacement of equipment to their Port Sulphur Water Treatment Plant.
- Over \$2 million in funding was obligated to the Orleans Levee District for repairs and safe operations of the Lakefront Airport.
- Over \$1.5 million in funding was obligated for mold remediation at the UNO Keifer Lakefront Arena.
