Project Description: The proposed scope of work for this project worksheet is considered as an alternative project. Project activities include turning the old ceramic classroom into a cafeteria extension. The re-design of the fine arts building, to include a cafeteria extension, does not change the size of the fine arts building. The work that needs to be done includes: lay tile on the 50' x 60' area where the old ceramic classroom was, replace all the mechanical, electrical, and lighting components, construct wall with gypsum board (estimated 2200 square feet for cafeteria extension), replace firetape and fire caulk, tape, float, and texture all exposed walls, apply two coats of finish paint to cafeteria, remove all unnecessary conduit, duct and miscellaneous wiring from exposed ceiling; then apply dry fall coating to the exposed ceilings. Install frame, doors, and all hardware associated with the installation process, rewiring of fire alarms, replace intercom systems, replace clock system, and replace sound systems.
