Since the federal disaster declaration for Tropical Storm Fred, Transylvania County residents have received more than \$891,231 in federal funds as of Oct. 6, 2021:

- \$90,214 in FEMA grants to homeowners and renters.
- \$801,017 in claims paid to National Flood Insurance Program policyholders.

Individual Assistance in Transylvania County:

- 19 homeowners and renters have been approved for \$90,214 in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program. This includes:
- \$72,797 in Housing Assistance grants for home repair, home replacement, and/or rental assistance.
- \$17,417 in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related costs.
- 18 homeowners and renters have been approved for rental assistance.
- 267 home inspections issued; 139 completed.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) visited 493 households in Transylvania County.
- A Document Drop-off Center operated in Brevard until Oct. 2 to help survivors with registration, application updates and referrals.
