## **Last Four FEMAs Disaster Recovery Centers to Close Permanently**

San Juan, Puerto Rico — The temporary Disaster Recovery Centers (DRCs) in Caguas, Mayagüez, Ponce and Vega Baja will close permanently on Dec. 8, 2022, at 5 p.m. Meanwhile, operational hours will be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. from Monday to Saturday until they close.

After DRCs close, survivors can still view the status of their application online at <a href="DisasterAssistance.gov">DisasterAssistance.gov</a> or by using <a href="FEMA's mobile app">FEMA's mobile app</a>. Individuals can also call <a href="the FEMA Helpline">the FEMA Helpline</a> at 1-800-621-3362 to discuss their case with a FEMA representative. Press 1 for English, 2 for Spanish and 3 for all other languages. People who use a relay service such as video relay service (VRS), captioned telephone service or others, provide FEMA the number for that service. Phone lines operate from 7 a.m. to 2 a.m. seven days a week.
