ST. LOUIS – The deadline to apply for FEMA Individual Assistance is drawing near for Missouri residents affected by the **May 16 disaster**.

If your home or personal property sustained damage not covered by insurance, FEMA may be able to provide money to help you pay for home repairs, a temporary place to live and replace essential personal property that was destroyed.

The fastest way to apply for Individual Assistance is at <u>DisasterAssistance.gov</u>. You may also apply by calling FEMA at 1-800-621-3362 or visiting a Disaster Recovery Center. The deadline to apply for FEMA Individual Assistance is **August 26, 2025**.
