SUBJECT: Fiscal Year 2024 State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program
Notices of Funding Opportunity

Today, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA), both components of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), are announcing the availability of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the State and Local Cybersecurity Grant Program (SLCGP). The FY 2024 SLCGP provides \$279,873,562 in federal assistance to state, local and territorial governments to assist with managing and reducing systemic cyber risk. The FY 2024 SLCGP NOFO may be found online at <http://www.fema.gov/grants> and at <http://www.grants.gov>.

Eligible applicants must apply for funding through the FEMA Grants Outcomes (FEMA GO) system portal at <http://go.fema.gov/>. Applicants are strongly encouraged to begin the application process as soon as possible, including obtaining a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) number. The UEI is a 12-character alphanumeric identification assigned to an entity by the System for Award Management (see SAM.gov). **The UEI is a required application element and may take up to four weeks to obtain.** Instructions on how to request a UEI can be found at <https://sam.gov/content/entity-registration>. To obtain the UEI, all applicants must register with SAM.

Failure to register with SAM will prevent an applicant from completing the application in FEMA GO. **Applicants are strongly encouraged to begin their application in FEMA GO at the time of this announcement** to ensure they have adequate time to start and complete their

submission. Completed applications for all grant programs must be submitted in FEMA GO no later than **5 p.m. ET, Dec. 3, 2024**.

Only final submissions made through the FEMA GO system located at <http://go.fema.gov/> will be accepted.
