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SUBJECT:	Nonprofit Security Grant Program - National Security Supplemental Initial Award Announcement

Today, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), a component of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS), is announcing an initial round of the final awards and allocations under the Nonprofit Security Grant Program - National Security Supplemental (NSGP-NSS). A second announcement will follow.

This supplemental funding is provided by the National Security Supplemental (*Israel Security Supplemental Appropriations Act,* 2024 (P.L. 118-50)). The NSGP-NSS provides \$210 million in funding for eligible nonprofit organizations to prevent, prepare for, protect against, and respond to acts of terrorism or other threats. Of this amount, \$105 million in funding is available to nonprofit organizations located within one of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI)-designated high-risk urban areas (NSGP-NSS-Urban Area or NSGP-NSS-UA). In addition, separate funding in the amount of \$105 million is available for nonprofit organizations located outside of the FY 2024 UASI-designated urban areas (NSGP-NSS-State or NSGP-NSS-S).

The intent of the NSGP-NSS is to award grant funding to assist nonprofit organizations at high risk of a terrorist or other extremist attack. These funds enable nonprofits to obtain the resources required to support and integrate their preparedness activities with broader state and local preparedness efforts. For example, the NSGP-NSS-UA and NSGP-NSS-S programs support facility hardening and physical security enhancements. The programs are designed to promote coordination and collaboration in emergency preparedness activities among public and private community representatives, as well as state and local government agencies.
