

 & unsatisfactory


Oklahoma Dam Inventory



Keys to Success

Dam Owner

- Motivated dam owners who strive to find funding
- Comply with federal requirements and time commitments
- Be prepared for when funding becomes available

State Program

- Patient, adaptable, and creative staff
- Regular and early communication with dam owners
- Established relationship with state, tribal and federal partners



Lessons Learned

- Lack of means or interest for funding programs
- Requirements beyond control/jurisdiction
- Early studies could reveal unknown issues
- Be proactive and track the rules/requirements changes constantly
- Prepare for review time delays
