the CTL has launched many educational, research, and industry/government outreach programs, including the MIT SCALE network involving six academic centers around the world. Recently, CTL has launched the on-line Micromaster's program, reaching over 300,000 students worldwide.

Outside the institute, Dr. Sheffi has consulted with numerous organizations. He has also founded or co-founded five successful companies, all acquired by large enterprises.

Dr. Sheffi has been recognized in numerous ways in academic and industry forums winning multiple awards and honors.

He obtained his Ph.D. from MIT in 1978.
