# **Collier County Recovery at a Glance as of Oct. 24, 2022**

Since the federal disaster declaration for Hurricane Ian, Collier County residents have received more than **\$62.5** million in federal funds as of Oct. 24, 2022:

- **\$33.1 million** in FEMA grants to homeowners and renters.
- \$13.6 million in U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) low-interest disaster loans approved for homeowners, renters and businesses.
- \$15.8 million in claims paid to National Flood Insurance Program policyholders.

#### Individual Assistance in Collier County

**11,305** homeowners and renters have been approved for **\$33,121,359** in federal grants through FEMA's Individuals and Households Program.

This includes:

- \$22,694,582 in Housing Assistance grants for home repair, home replacement, and/or rental assistance.
- \$10,426,777 in Other Needs Assistance grants to replace essential household items and for other critical disaster-related expenses.
- 2,536 homeowners and renters have been approved for rental assistance.
- 6,734 home inspections issued; 6,425 completed.
- Disaster Survivor Assistance (DSA) visited 3,565 households in Collier County.

#### **U.S. Small Business Administration**

**SBA has approved \$13,627,000** in low-interest disaster loans to **170** applicants in Collier County.
